

Getting to Hospital

Are you are a patient registered with a Wiltshire GP?

Do you think you need help from the NHS to get to hospital because your health condition impacts on your ability to use routine transport (cars/trains/buses/taxis/wheelchair taxis)?

If yes, call the **Patient Transport Advice Centre** on **01278 727410*** between 8.30am and 6.30pm Monday to Friday and have your NHS number available.

The NHS staff there will ask you about your needs and, if you qualify, will book your transport with Arriva Transport Solutions Ltd on your behalf.

If you don't qualify, they may be able to suggest alternative means of transport for you to get to your appointment.

*Calls to the advice centre will be charged at standard geographic call rate and will be recorded for training and monitoring purposes.
